

Orientation of District Council Officials on Climate Change and Climate Justice

CISONECC in collaboration with CADECOM National Office with support from Scottish Government, through SCIAF and Trocaire, under the *Climate Challenge Programme Malawi (CCPM) - Climate Justice Advocacy Project (CJAP)* conducted a workshop in Liwonde, Machinga in July, 2019 to raise awareness of district council officials from Chikwawa, Balaka, Zomba and Machinga on Climate Change and Climate Justice. The workshop also focused on sensitizing the district council officials on the Development, Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation of the National Adaptation Plan; and to share outcomes and recommendations from the work on documentation of climate change injustices in Chikwawa, Balaka, Zomba and Machinga.

The outcome of the workshop was enhanced capacity of district duty bearers on their roles on climate change and delivery of climate justice in their communities. The officials were also equipped with knowledge on climate change as well as climate change policy framework in Malawi and internationally. Participants were also made aware of the various platforms established to mobilize resources (funds, human capital) for fighting Climate Change at global level and lobbying for adaptation financing in the Least Developed Countries.
